FIRST AID

EYE CONTACT - IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue cautiously rinsing eye. Have the product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice or attention.

SKIN CONTACT - IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing and wash it before reuse. Wash skin with plenty of soap and water. Call a poison center, doctor, chemical manufacturer, importer, or distributor to specify the appropriate source of emergency medical advice. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice or attention.

INGESTION - IF SWALLOWED: Unless advised otherwise by a poison control center or doctor, have person rinse mouth with water, if able. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Immediately call a poison center, doctor, chemical manufacturer, importer, or distributor to specify the appropriate source of emergency medical advice.

INHALATION - IF INHALED: If breathing is difficult, remove person to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, and then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth if possible.

GENERAL INFORMATION

CLUB LINE ORGANOSILICONE is an organosilicone nonionic surfactant mixture designed for water-based herbicide application. **CLUB LINE ORGANOSILICONE** wets and spreads more efficiently than standard 90/10 or 80/20 nonionic surfactants without the runoff or damage that sometimes occurs with 100% organosilicone surfactants. **CLUB LINE ORGANOSILICONE** is designed for fast spreading; uniform distribution and absorption of spray on leaf and stem surfaces. **CLUB LINE ORGANOSILICONE** may be used with most pesticides and fertilizer products. Optimum application and consequent effects can be influenced by many factors. It is recommended that the spray be observed and adjuvant rates be adjusted accordingly. During application insure thorough coverage without excessive runoff.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Always follow the directions on the label of the pest control agent being used. **CLUB LINE ORGANOSILICONE** is designed for use where an organosilicone surfactant is recommended or not forbidden. Suggested rates for the use with various categories of pest control agents are as follows:

NOTE: Carefully read and follow the specific directions contained on the label of the chemical used. Before adding **CLUB LINE ORGANOSILICONE** to spray tank mixes or before using with a pesticide or fertilizer where a nonionic adjuvant is not specifically recommended but not prohibited by the manufacturer, the user or application advisor must have experience with the combination or must have conducted a phytotoxicity trial and compatibility (jar) test of their own.

Aerial Application: When applying aerially, follow pesticide label directions including minimum water volume per acre. Do not substitute **CLUB LINE ORGANOSILICONE** for water required by the pesticide label.

For increased water penetration of hard to wet soils and the uniform distribution of applied moisture follow recommended uses:

APPLICATION RATE	PER 1000 SQ. FEET
Lawns and Turf:	6 to 16 ounces.
Greens and Tees:	6 to 16 ounces.
Deep Feeding Trees:	12 to 25 ounces.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Spray mixing and application equipment must be cleaned according to cleaning directions on prior pesticide label before application.

To minimize foaming, fill spray tank 2/3 or 3/4 full of water. If foaming is anticipated, an antifoaming agent should be added before **CLUB LINE ORGANOSILICONE**. While under agitation, pesticides and/or fertilizers should be added as directed by label or in the following sequence: Powders (soluble), Powders (dry), Liquid flowables and suspensions, Emulsifiable concentrates and solutions.

While agitating, add **CLUB LINE ORGANOSILICONE** and mix for 1 to 2 minutes with lower than normal agitation. Continue filling tank maintaining minimal agitation.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool well-ventilated place. Keep in original container tightly closed. Do not reuse empty container. Do not store with food, feed, or other material to be used or consumed by humans or animals. Do not contaminate water supplies. For optimal storage, store between 40° and 90° F. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Dispose of contents in container to an approved waste disposal facility in accordance with all federal, state and local regulations. Triple rinse (or equivalent) adding rinse water to application tank. Offer container for recycling or dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by local regulations. NOTE: Keep out of lakes, ponds or streams. Do not contaminate water sources by run-off from cleaning of equipment, disposal of rinse waters or spray mixtures.
